A message from...

Secretary-Treasurer David W. Laughton

The Executive Board of Teamsters Local 633 and I have endorsed Governor John Lynch for re-election as governor of our great State. Governor Lynch outlined his priorities in 2004, which were better jobs, a better economy, better schools, and more affordable health care. Inaugurated as New Hampshire's 80th governor in January 2005, John Lynch is bringing a renewed spirit of bipartisan cooperation to the State House and working to make progress on the issues important to New Hampshire working families. In his first term in office, Governor Lynch has kept his promise to bring Democrats, Republicans and Independents together to address New Hampshire's major challenges. Under John Lynch, New Hampshire erased a major budget deficit and balanced the budget without new taxes – and even invested \$50 million dollars in the state's rainy day fund. At the same time, New Hampshire has made important investments in expanding access to health care, job creation and economic development and in education at all levels.

Governor Lynch worked with Democrats and Republicans in the Legislature to put in place one of the toughest and most comprehensive laws to protect children from sexual predators, to repeal a law that had doubled and tripled health insurance premiums for many small businesses and to end the ability of insurance companies to discriminate against sick

workers, to pass new laws to reduce mercury emissions and protect ground water, and to enact comprehensive ethics reform, including creating the first ethics commission for the executive branch.

Governor Lynch is continuing to work to expand opportunities for New Hampshire citizens. Among his priorities are increasing New Hampshire's high school graduation rate by expanding alternative learning programs and requiring young people to stay in school until they reach 18, or receive their high school diplomas, rather than letting them drop out at 16.

Governor Lynch's commitment to putting the interests of people first is an extension of his work as a business and community leader.

Let's all give Governor John Lynch the support he deserves by voting November 7, 2006 for a real friend

of the Teamsters and all working families in New Hampshire.

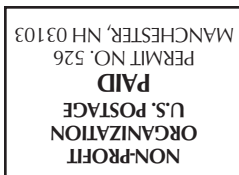
